

Every 8,000 kilometres or 6 months (whichever comes first)

4 Salt, Dust, & Mud

Replace Engine Oil and Filter

Modern engine oils do more than lubricate-they help remove harmful engine deposits and contaminants as you drive. The oil suspends these contaminants and carries them to the oil filter where they are trapped and held. Eventually, the oil filter becomes so saturated with these contaminants that its filtering capability is significantly reduced or made totally ineffective.

If the oil filter is not replaced at the recommended intervals, unfiltered oil will continue to flow through the engine and cause excessive wear, which will reduce performance and ultimately shorten the life of the engine.

SYNTHETIC OIL

Why is it important to use a synthetic oil that cleans?

A clean engine is better protected and more responsive. It's a fact of life that all engines generate contaminants. Contaminants such as soot, carbon, sulfuric and nitric acid are inevitable by-products of the combustion process; and all of them end up in your motor oil to varying degrees. So the question isn't whether you need an oil that cleans, but how well your oil cleans the dirt and deposits your engine generates.

Why Trade Up to a Full Synthetic Oil?

Part of the job of an engine oil is to suspend the contaminants within the oil until your next oil change. It's a fairly daunting task for engine oil to suspend all the contaminants thrown at it; the truth is that full synthetic motor oils do a better job than conventional oils and synthetic blends can do.







- 5 | Unload the tires from your vehicle.
- 6 | Place tires upright on tire tracks.
- 7 | Store the tires in a cool, dry place.
- 8 | Check the air pressure before remounting.

The Importance of Nissan Brake Service

We will provide a complete inspection of your brake hardware, hydraulics, friction material and emergency brake (brake pads, caliper sliders, shoes, rotors, or drums, brake lines and fluid). We will provide you with a report on what can wait or what may need attention right now.

With brake service you can extend the life of your brakes and improve performance. Brake pads and caliper sliders can become stuck over time due to moisture, dirt, road salt and freezing weather. Proper cleaning of these components will typically help extend brake life.

For optimal service, brakes should be serviced by Nissan trained technicians every 24,000 service intervals.

MAINTENANCE Driveline and 4/4 Fluid Replacement

The differential is the melon shaped part that sits between the wheels. It is the last stop along the drivetrain before torque is transferred to the wheels. The differential allows the wheels to rotate at different speeds for effective 4 wheel and or all wheel driving. It transfers torque to the wheels, causing them to spin, which in turn moves the car.

The purpose of the differential fluid is to cool and lubricate your differential. Without the oil your differential would overheat due to the metal-to-metal contact and burn itself out. Because the differential is at the rear and under the car, it doesn't get serviced on regular basis. But if lubrication in the differential fails, you won't be getting very far for very long.

All drive-line fluids serve the same basic purpose: they help protect the gears from corrosion, heat and most other damaging elements.

The transfer case is a gearbox found only in four-wheel drive and some all-wheel drive vehicles that sends drive power from the engine to the front axles. Lubricating fluid inside the transfer case draws heat away from the gears, helping to preserve the life and performance. This fluid should be changed upon recommendation or more often if offroading/towing/hauling etc.

Rear Differential is a messy job meant for a Nissan technician. For timing of changing the fluid: if you are towing or hauling or your vehicle experiences temperature fluctuations - this fluid requires inspection of quality and should be changed based on recommendation.

Once the fluid is drained and completely replaced, you are good to go. This service should be completed every 50,000 kms.







Replace Engine Oil and Filter

Modern engine oils do more than lubricate-they help remove harmful engine deposits and contaminants as you drive. The oil suspends these contaminants and carries them to the oil filter where they are trapped and held. Eventually, the oil filter becomes so saturated with these contaminants that its filtering capability is significantly reduced or made totally ineffective.

If the oil filter is not replaced at the recommended intervals, unfiltered oil will continue to flow through the engine and cause excessive wear, which will reduce performance and ultimately shorten the life of the engine.



Rotate and Balance Tires

Regular tire rotation prolongs tire life. Tires are inspected for wear, improper alignment, inflation pressure, and steering/suspension concerns. Tire balance should be checked every year, or when a vibration is noticed in the steering.






MAINTENANCE Drive Belts

Drive belts, once called fan belts or alternator belts, play a vital role in the operation of the engine. While the engine is running, power is transmitted through one or more drive belts to a number of vital external engine components. Among the systems that depend on drive belts for power are the alternator, which supplies the entire vehicle with its electrical requirements, and the power steering pump, which provides power assist to the steering system.

Should a drive belt fail, these systems will cease to function and the steering will immediately become stiff. A warning light on the instrument panel immediately alerts the driver about the failure and the vehicle can still be safely driven for a short period of time. It is recommended that you contact our service department immediately to arrange for the installation of a Genuine Nissan Drive Belt.



Engine Coolant Flush and Fill

Antifreeze serves two important functions: protecting the cooling system at temperature extremes and inhibiting rust and corrosion in the system. Many antifreezes also have additives that help lubricate the water pump and thermostat, so coolant has multiple advantages over just plain water.



Wheel Alignment (Coupon on page 26)

Hitting potholes, rubbing curbs and bumping concrete parking stops knock things in your steering and suspension around and, eventually, things are not straight anymore. Keeping your wheels aligned will prevent tire wear, increase fuel mileage by reducing road friction, and improve the vehicle's handling.

Even without abuse, front wheel alignment will change under normal, everyday driving conditions. The change may be so gradual that it is not noticed at first. A wheel alignment is highly recommended during seasonal tire changes at least once a year by most tire manufacturers.

Rotate and Balance Tires

Regular tire rotation prolongs tire life. Tires are inspected for wear, improper alignment, inflation pressure, and steering/suspension concerns. Tire balance should be checked every year, or when a vibration is noticed in the steering.




